Cabernet Franc 2000

This wine is a blend of Cabernet Franc from two different appellations, Cienega Valley in San Benito Co. and our own Paso Robles. Both appellations are moderately warm coastal locations; just the type of climates ideal for making quality red wines.

Cabernet Franc is a highly regarded variety originating from the Bordeaux region of France, often being blended with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Malbec. The Castoro Cellars Cabernet Franc is 85% Cabernet Franc and 15% Petite Verdot.

You will find this wine of medium body while elegant in character. The aroma is of ripe fruit with flowery notes, plus it has the added complexity of oak vanillins. The tannins are moderate and the wine will continue to age favorably over the next several years.
