This grape originates from France but carries a German name. Gewürztraminer is an outstanding wine found in the Alsace region of France. The area is heavily influenced by Germany in architecture, food, and wine style. These grapes have a beautiful golden hue when ripe and are from our SIP Certified Estate Vineyards. The aromas are floral and exotic: jasmine, lychee, wet stone, and crystalized ginger. The mouthfeel is delicate with juicy pear balanced with yellow grapefruit on the finish. Delicious with sushi, Thai cuisine, and spicy appetizers or cuisine. Serve chilled.
